

One thing we all have in common is to want peace in our lives. The important question is, "What or whom do I pursue to find peace? Do I rely on what the World offers or Jesus?"

Even those who have accepted Jesus as their Savior and Leader can easily adopt the means the World offers as short-cuts to prosperity and security. The World's solutions can give temporary peace, but sooner or later will be found to be inadequate. For example, if my source of peace is possessions, I will constantly need to replace or repair them to stay ahead. Or if I use alcohol or drugs, I will eventually sober up and not only need more but have to face the consequences of being out of commission.

Take some time now and honestly evaluate what it is you depend on for peace in your life. Write down the ones that come to mind.

Now imagine that Jesus is sitting next to you, looks you in the eye and says...

"I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give isn't like the peace the world gives. So, don't be troubled or afraid...I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."

These are His promises of hope and peace to everyone who has surrendered their life to trust and follow Him.

If you have accepted Him, ask Him now to help you to trust Him fully in all areas of your life – especially the ones where you are fearful, anxious and peace-less. He is ready to help if you will ask.

Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.

Matthew 11:28-30 (NLT)

If you are not yet a follower, listen to what Jesus offers. What difference might it make in your life if you lived with Jesus in the lead? What would you need to know, understand or overcome to accept Him? He wants a relationship with you but will never force the issue.
