How to Make Good, Wise Decisions

1. Go to God and ask for His help.

⁵ If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. ⁶ But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. ⁷ Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. ⁸ Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do. James 1:5–8 (NLT)

2. Find out what the Bible says.

¹⁶ All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. ¹⁷ God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16–17 (NLT) 3. Ask for insight and advice from <u>wise followers</u> of Christ.

Refuse good advice and watch your plans fail; take good counsel and watch them succeed. Proverbs 15:22 (MSG)

4. Be willing to make a <u>painful choice</u> if that is what is <u>required</u> to be faithful.

...if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it.

So Here's Our List or Decision Guide

1. Go to God and ask for His help.

2. Find out what the Bible has to say.

3. Ask for insight and advice from wise followers of Christ.

4. Be willing to make a painful choice if that is what is required.

And the final item...

5. Trust God and do whatever you want!

⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. ⁶ Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. ⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the LORD and turn away from evil.

⁴ Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you your heart's desires. ⁵ Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust him, and he will help you. Psalm 37:4–5 (NLT)

If we are following the first four items in our checklist, we are in the <u>perfect position</u> to make decisions that will be the very best.

Sometimes God makes the best choice <u>perfectly</u> <u>clear</u> and other times He <u>leaves it to our</u> <u>discernment</u>.

He will do what is <u>best for us</u> so we grow in our faith and <u>show others</u> the surpassing value of knowing and following Jesus.
