Four ways the church gets it wrong and can do better:

Judging others rather than loving them.

Ranting about/to others rather than <u>listening</u> to them.

Acting <u>hypocritically</u> rather than <u>humbly</u>.

<u>Accommodating</u> what God says is <u>wrong</u> rather than <u>courageously representing</u> truth.

There are <u>many important</u> things Jesus' church should be involved with but there is one that is <u>essential</u> and should <u>always be our priority</u>.


