The following passage gives the context for the verse we explored and illustrated with the movie. Read this aloud and then ask yourself how you can make the three commands a greater part of your life starting this week. Pray that we will carry this out as a church too!

¹ Listen to what the LORD is saying: Stand up and state your case against me. Let the mountains and hills be called to witness your complaints. ² And now, O mountains, listen to the LORD's complaint! He has a case against his people. He will bring charges against Israel. ³ O my people, what have I done to you? What have I done to make you tired of me? Answer me! ⁴ For I brought you out of Egypt and redeemed you from slavery. I sent Moses, Aaron, and Miriam to help you. ⁵ Don't you remember, my

people, how King Balak of Moab tried to have you cursed and how Balaam son of Beor blessed you instead? And remember your journey from Acacia Grove to Gilgal, when I, the LORD, did everything I could to teach you about my faithfulness. ⁶ What can we bring to the LORD? What kind of offerings should we give him? Should we bow before God with offerings of yearling calves? ⁷ Should we offer him thousands of rams and ten thousand rivers of olive oil? Should we sacrifice our firstborn children to pay for our sins? ⁸ No, O people, the LORD has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God. ⁹ Fear the LORD if you are wise! His voice calls to everyone in Jerusalem: The armies of destruction are coming; the LORD is sending them. ¹⁰ What shall I say about the homes of the wicked filled with treasures gained by cheating? What about the disgusting practice of measuring out grain with dishonest measures? ¹¹ How can I tolerate your merchants who use dishonest scales and weights? ¹² The rich among you have become wealthy through extortion and violence. Your citizens are so used to lying that their tongues can no longer tell the truth. ¹³ Therefore, I will wound you! I will bring you to ruin for all your sins. ¹⁴ You will eat but never have enough. Your hunger pangs and emptiness will remain. And though you try to save your money, it will come to nothing in the end. You will save a little, but I will give it to those who conquer you.

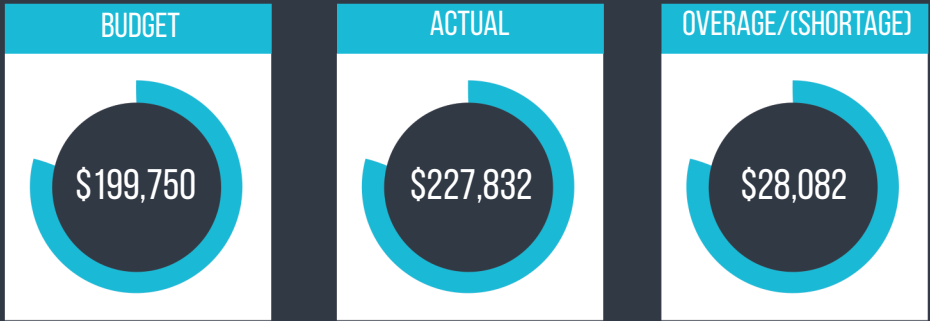

Starting Point groups are safe places for people with questions about faith, as well as those who want to learn about the Bible and Christianity. Groups meet for 9 weeks to explore the grand story of the Bible.

- STARTERS: those who have just begun a relationship with Jesus Christ
- RETURNERS: those who have some church experience, but have been away for a while

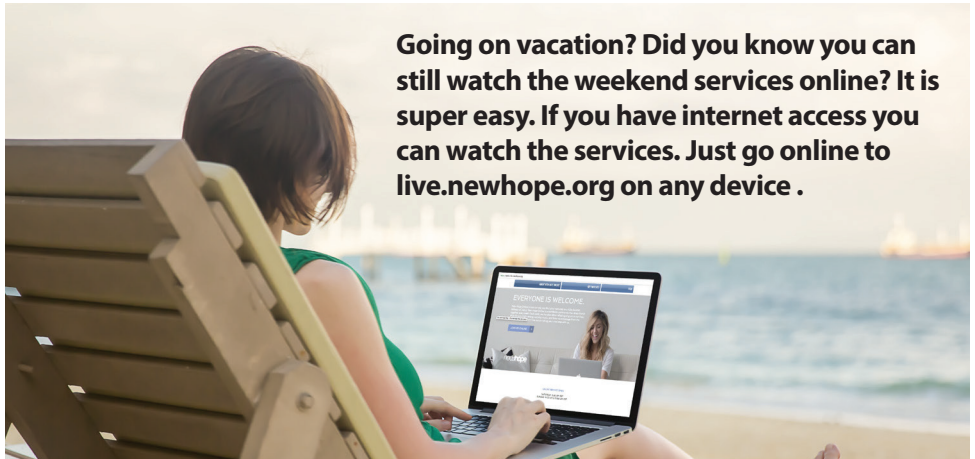
The group will begin on Saturday, September 15th and end on Saturday, November 10th. This group meets at New Hope during the Saturday 5:30 pm service.
