Peace (def): prosperity, tranquility, quiet, security, harmony

Think about your circle of relationships – family, friends, co-workers, neighbors, classmates etc....

Think about the general pattern of how you relate with these different people. Be honest.

Who are you really honest and forthright with?

Who are you more superficial with?

Are there any you are afraid to be really honest with?

Are there some that you kind of walk over because you can get away with it?

Are there some who walk all over you because you let them?

Now, take a few moments and consider how you relate to these people in light of the passages that we studied in the message.

1. What is a way I could step out and be more truthful in a relationship where I have avoided it merely to "keep the peace" at the expense of love and truth?

2. Who in my circle may be avoiding being truthful with me to avoid my fragility or fury? Am I willing to invite them to be honest with me? [It would have to be with a commitment to humbly listen without arguing!]

To avoid negative repercussions.

Reasons people opt for faux-peace with us:

To avoid our fragility or our fury.

The remedy is to <u>speak the truth in love</u> and to <u>invite</u> it!

This will give us <u>peace with God</u>, as we pursue peace with others.

Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.




