LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Key Verse: John 14:16, 25-26 (read these verses aloud as a group)

1. Pastor Chris suggests that many Christians know Jesus well but know the Holy Spirit least of all. Do you agree with this assessment, and if so, what might be hindering deeper fellowship with the Holy Spirit?

2. The sermon describes the Holy Spirit as a comforter who not only consoles but also confronts and convicts us of sin. How have you experienced this dual nature of comfort and confrontation in your spiritual journey?

3. The sermon emphasizes learning to hear the Holy Spirit's still small voice rather than waiting for Him to speak louder. What spiritual disciplines or practices help you discern His voice among the many voices competing for your attention?

4. Read Romans 8:14, & Galatians 5:18 together. How does the concept of being led by the Spirit differ from simply being instructed by the Spirit, and what does true obedience to His leading look like in your life?
