LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Key Verse: Acts 1:8 - But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

1. 1 Corinthians 14:1 states that we should eagerly desire the gifts of the Spirit (tongues, interpretation of tongues, prophecy, discerning spirits, miraculous powers, word of wisdom, word of knowledge, gift of faith, healing). Which gift (or gifts) do you most eagerly desire?

2. Pastor Chris used Jesus being led by the Spirit into the wilderness as a picture of submission to the Spirit. What is one area where you sense the Spirit nudging you (something to start, stop, or surrender), and what support would help you follow through?

3. Share with the group a story of a time you experienced the power of a gift of the Spirit in your life, either by observing it or experiencing it first-hand.

4. The sermon challenged low expectations about God moving today. Where do you personally land (e.g. hopeful, skeptical, tired, curious, confident). What is one specific situation you're willing to bring to The Holy Spirit with expectation this week and keep bringing, even if nothing changes overnight?
