LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Key Verse: Mark 16:6-7 - "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. ⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'"

1. How did you celebrate Easter this year?

2. As a group, read aloud Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Romans 5:8, Romans 10:9-11, John 3:16, and John 14:6. Afterward, share how confident you feel about guiding someone through a prayer of salvation and addressing any questions they might have. Please explain in detail.

3. Which of the following three perspectives do you most identify with, and why? Peter, who denied Jesus through his words or actions; Mary, who was given the first commandment to go and share the gospel; or Barabbas, for whom Jesus took the rightful place of punishment and shame?

4. Can you think of someone in your life whom Jesus is prompting you to talk to about salvation or rededicating their life to Christ? As a group, let's come together and pray for those individuals this evening.
