LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Key Verse: Ephesians 6 -16-17 – In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

1. What does it mean to you personally that the helmet of salvation is described as ornate, intricate, and beautiful, something that should draw others to notice Christ in you?

2. Read Philippians 2:12-13 as a group. In what practical ways can you 'work out your salvation with fear and trembling' without falling into the trap of trying to earn salvation through good works?

3. Read the following verses a loud: Eph2:8-10, 1 Cor 1:18, Rom 13:11, Phil 1:6. How does understanding your salvation as past, present, and future (we have been saved, are being saved, and will be saved) change the way you approach your daily Christian walk? (*Note the emphasis is on you, not them.*)

4. Do you agree that the Christian life should become easier as you mature spiritually and understand the full armor of God, or does this contradict your experience and why?
