The Third Passover

- Importance through Biblical history
 - The first; start of the exodus from Egypt Exodus 12
 - Freedom from over 400 years of slavery
 - In with 70... out with the over 600,000
 - Before leaving Egypt... anticipation of fulfillment



The Third Passover

- Importance through Biblical history
 - The first; start of the exodus from Egypt Exodus 12
 - The first in the Promise Land Joshua 5:10-12
 - After crossing the Jordon River
 - Before their first battle
 - Reestablishment of God's covenant
 - Manna ceased

 - Much teaching with His disciples

The Third Passover Meaning Of The Passover

- God moving His people from slavery to freedom
- Remembering the time and way God worked to fulfill His promise
- Preparing for Passover... more than a day



The Third Passover
Meaning Of The Passover
Completing Christ's Earthly Ministry

- Moments away from the cross and fulfilling the Father's will
- Taught with authority
- Taught principles
- Demonstrated His power through miracles

The Significance

Emphasizes Given

- The bread
 - Unleavened bread
 - Leaven used as an illustration of sin –
 1 Corinthians 5:6-8; Galatians 5:9
 - "I Am the Bread of Life" John 6:25-59

The Significance

Emphasizes Given

- The bread
- The cup
 - Each cup in a traditional Passover has a different and significant meaning
 - Last cup
 - Cup of praise
 - Future redemption of Israel

The Significance

Emphasizes Given

New Meanings Given

- The bread is the body of Christ
- The cup is the blood of Christ
- The Lamb of God John 1:29
 - Reflection back to Exodus
 - The lamb was prepared and eaten
 - The blood of the lamb placed on the post of the door brought salvation... passing over sparing life

The Significance

Emphasizes Given New Meanings Given Instead Of The Old

- Christ broke from the traditional Passover rituals
- Demonstrating He is the anticipated Messiah

The Implications

Bold Proclamation Being Fulfilled

- "That takes away the sins of the world"
- Never hunger John 4:31-38
- Poured out for sins



The Implications

Bold Proclamation Being Fulfilled New Covenant

- Promise between God and mankind
- Foundation of the new covenant is anchored in the blood of Christ
- No more sacrificial system... He is the Lamb

- All believers worshiping Christ in the kingdom forever
