- Demonstration of Jesus deity

Isaiah 42:8

I am the LORD; that is my name; my glory I give to no other, nor my praise to carved idols.

Isaiah 48:11

For my own sake, for my own sake, I do it, for how should my name be profaned? My glory I will not give to another.



FATHER & SON (vs. 1-5)

Glorifying

- The Father glorifying the Son
- Demonstration of Jesus's deity (Isaiah 42:8; 48:11)
- God is glorified through the cross because God fulfills His covenant
 - Sin leads to death
 - · God does not bend the rule
 - God is committed to His holiness
 Romans 8:32
 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

- Longing since the fall of humanity in the Garden of Eden



I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.
