- For a season
- For a reason
- 2 Kings 18-20 King Hezekiah
 - Both Isaiah and Micah prophies concerning the fall of Judah
 - Evil desires against God prevailed increasingly
- 2 Kings 24:18-25:30 King Zedekiah
 - Judah fell to Nebuchadnezzar
 - Destruction of Jerusalem and the temple
 - Exiles taken to Babylon

- All in God's timing





- Any nation or people that did not obey


