- The reason for the unrest
 - Trouble in Bethany
 - Triumphant entry in Jerusalem
 - Temple cleansing
 - Teaching in the Temple
 - Demonstration of servanthood through foot-washing
 - One would betray – Judas exits
 - Jesus tells Peter that he would deny him three times before morning

- “I am the way” – sin put to death through the cross of Jesus making the way to the Father
- “I am the truth” – all the Old Testament prophecies and teachings, only true teaching of God
- “I am the life” – we are all born spiritually dead, BUT believing in Jesus brings eternal life

- Jesus’s work – teaching and miracles – revealed the Father
