Luke 15:11–32

And he said, "There was a man who had two sons. And the younger of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of property that is coming to me.' And he divided his property between them. Not many days later, the younger son gathered all he had and took a journey into a far country, and there he squandered his property in reckless living. And when he had spent everything, a severe famine arose in that country, and he began to be in need. So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, who sent him into his fields to feed pigs. - Squandered
- Reckless living
- Immoral living (vs. 30)

The Key To Context Arrogance In Control Ignorance In Control Reality In Control

- Hard rock bottom
- All spent
- Severe famine
- Began to have need...the first time in his life



Hope Misplaced

The Key To Context Arrogance In Control Ignorance In Control Reality In Control Desperation In Control

- Hire hand to a foreigner
- Ethic dilemma
 - Unclean animal care
 - Hunger kicks in
 - Desiring even the pig's food
 - No one would help him
 - Far from his father's table

Recognizing Of Need

- Brokenness must he acknowledged
- Understanding a better way
- Do not neglect the spiritual responsibilities
- Humility brings clarity
- A plan must have action that starts with the first step

Recognizing Of Need Reckless Love

- But the father
- Saw and recognized from far off the son's return
- Compassion loving his son regardless of condition
- Ran unlikely action by an elder father towards son
- Embraced think Jacob and Joseph reunited
- Kissed acceptance without requirements

Repentance In Action

- Understanding the wrong
- Understanding the severity of action God and father
- Responsibility for sin
- Turning away from sin
- Returning to God's plan

- But...the father's plan not the son's plan
- Best robe not just any robe
- Ring of relationship and responsibility
- Shoes to walk a new path

Disheartened Discovery

- No excitement for his brother's return
- No consideration of the father's excitement

Disheartened Discovery Disrespectful Display

- Refusal to go to his father
- No part in the celebration
 - Anger
 - Not compassion
- Father's desire



Hope Misunderstood

Disheartened Discovery Disrespectful Display Dissatisfied Discipline

- The elder son lived a disciplined life
 - Faithful following father's wishes
 - Living by the rules
 - Seemly no rewards
- The younger son received no discipline for wrong
 - Devoured property
 - Immoral
 - Rewarded with celebration

Disheartened Discovery Disrespectful Display Dissatisfied Discipline Dad's Delight

- Clarification for celebration
- Elder son must choose to celebrate
- Younger son demonstrates true repentance
- Receives hope
