Reality #1

If you are a true follower of Christ (Christian), God's love you does not end even when you feel unlovable or undeserving of love.

Reality #2

God has not and will not leave you orphaned if you are follower of Christ.

Reality #3

God has designed a plan for church to a partnership between Himself and believers in Christ. This partnership is not restrained to the walls of building, social economic status, ethnic heritage, or any other dynamic except the gospel



Reality #4

God's design for church is formed from uniquely designed believers. As church, we are called to one body with different giftings with one passion for Jesus Christ.



Ephesians 2:11-22

11 Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called "the uncircumcision" by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands-¹² remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. 14 For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility 15 by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, 16 and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. ¹⁷ And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. 18 For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. 19 So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

- You have passed from death to eternal life



Destitute Before Christ Ephesians 2:11-12

Remember the anchor of salvation Without God's plan in action

- Separated from access to God alienated
 - "Gentile" non-Jewish
 - Not identified through a covenant to God
- Original covenants
 - Old Testament redemptive plan
 - Pointing to Messiah Jesus Christ
 - Abrahamic
 - Mosaic
 - Davidic



Destitute Before Christ Ephesians 2:11-12

Remember the anchor of salvation Without God's plan in action Culturally isolated

- Racial tensions in society
- In the church
- No hope even through Judaism at the temple

BUT...

- In Christ you...
 - Were (past tense) far off
 - Have been brought (present tense) near
- By the blood of Jesus
- Peace not strife
 - Remember the divide racial
 - Remember the divide religious
 - Dividing wall of hostility
 - Abolishing the law by fulfilling the law



BUT...

- Two old
 - The division of Jew and Gentile Romans 5:12–13

Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned—for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not counted where there is no law.
