
The next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. But when the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and began to contradict what was spoken by Paul, reviling him. And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken first to you. Since you thrust it aside and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles. For so the Lord has commanded us, saying,

"'I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.'"

And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed. And the word of the Lord was spreading throughout the whole region. But the Jews incited the devout women of high standing and the leading men of the city, stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of

Religious Competition And Conflict

- As the church is planted
 - The movement away from the established
 - Paul and Barnabas urged to stay and continue to teach the grace of God
 - o "The Jews"
 - Filled with jealousy when they saw the crowds
 - Began to spread contradiction to the gospel

Fury

Religious Competition And Conflict Religion Only Exist With Control

- Reoccurring oppression through the first century church
 - Conflict in the earthly ministry of Jesus
 - Extends to the birth of the Church Age
 - Continues through today
- Religion seeks to control a person's actions and thoughts
 - Christianity is a relationship not obligation
