“The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,” and


“A stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense.”



 - Well known teacher - Gamaliel
 - Words of wisdom concerning opposing God or man - Acts 5:33-42
 - Well known and respected
 - Strictly taught the law as a Pharisee



- Blameless according to the law
- Passionately attempting to stop the church
 - Against his teacher's words of wisdom
 - His hatred grew stronger for believers



If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless.



- Ravaged the church – Acts 8:1-3
 - God scattered believers to fulfill the Great Commission
- Goal – ending “The Way” in Damascus







- Discoverable



 - Not a title given by the church



- “Saints”
- Ephesus
 - Started at the end of Paul’s Second Missionary Journey (Acts 18:19-21) – 51AD
 - Return during the Paul’s Third Missionary Journey (Acts 19)
 - Two year stay and ministry – 52AD-55AD
 - From Ephesus and beyond


More Than A Title



- Massive city-wide riot



- Continue to remember grace is through Christ Jesus







Peace


God
