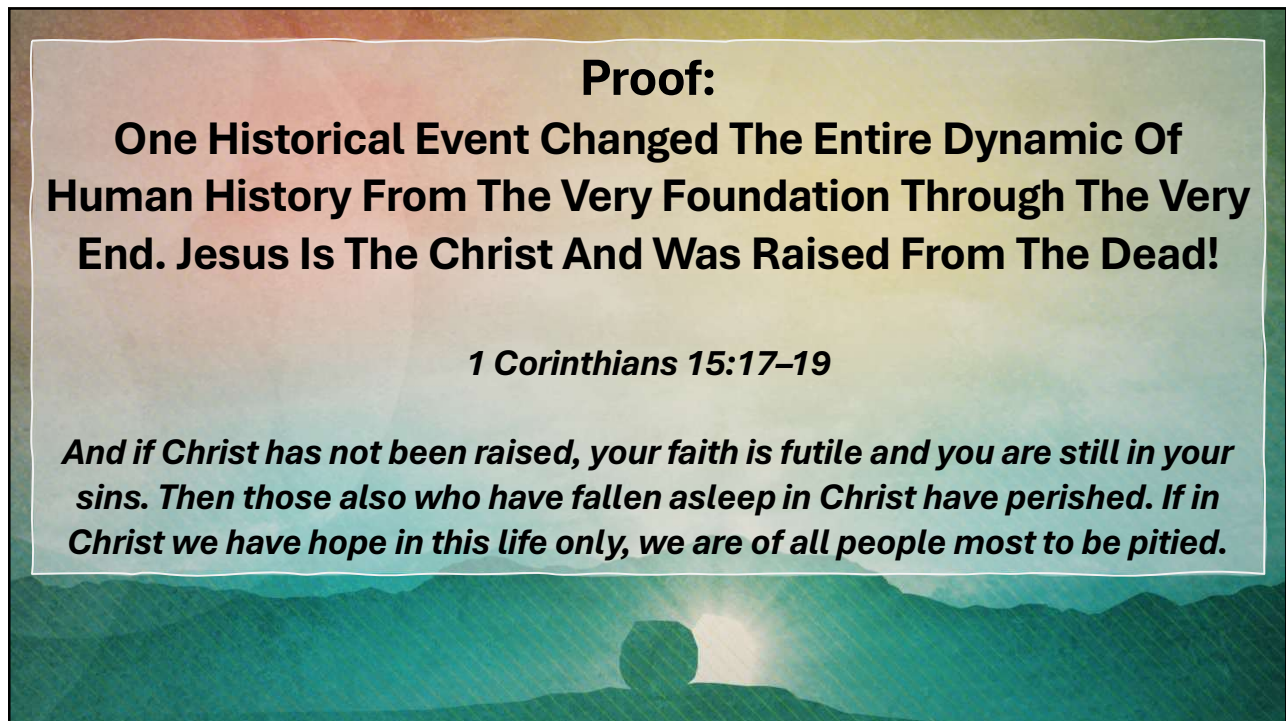




Disappointment – vs. 13-24




- Identifying Jesus

- Witnessed evidence was not sufficient

- Fulfillment of the Prophets
 - Beginning with Moses – sacrificial system established
 - The Prophets – Christ must suffer
- Words and teaching of Christ about Himself

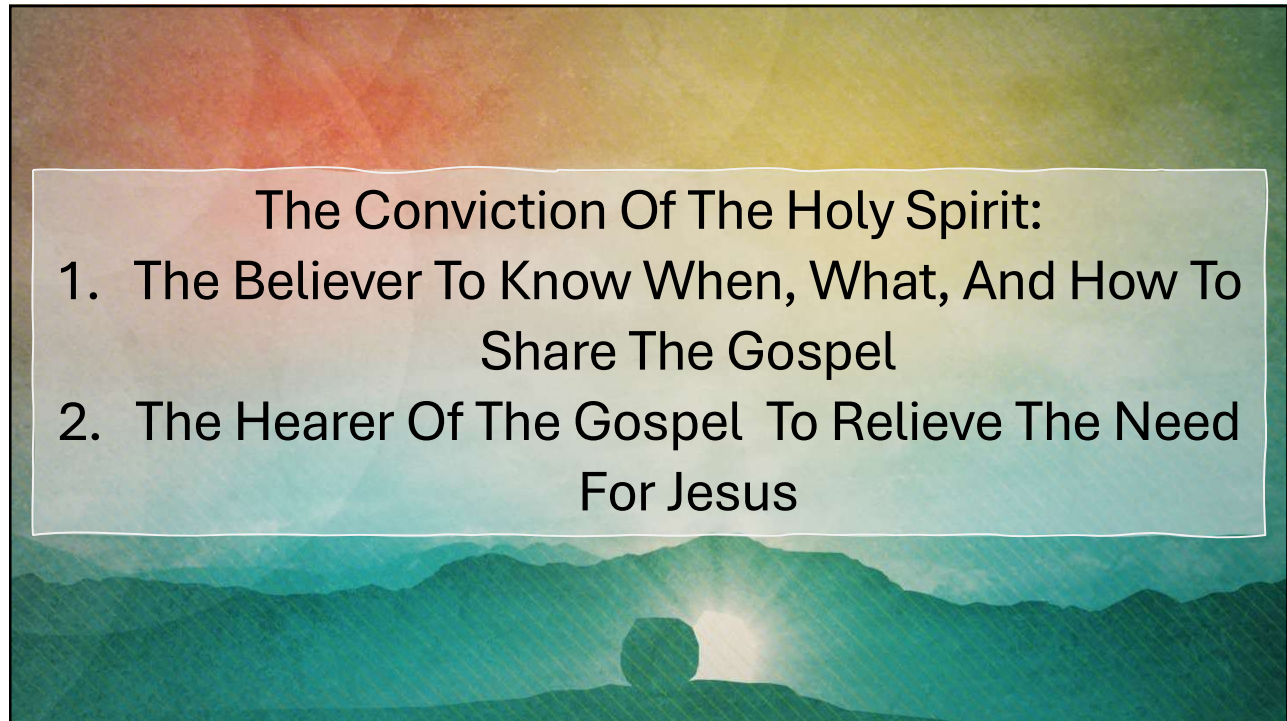
Foolish Heart Exposed

The Work Of The Holy Spirit - Luke 24:16

But their eyes were kept from recognizing Him.

- Personal witness and revelation through the Holy Spirit
- Reoccurring during the earthly ministry of Christ
 - Was not the right time
 - Limited understanding only for the disciples



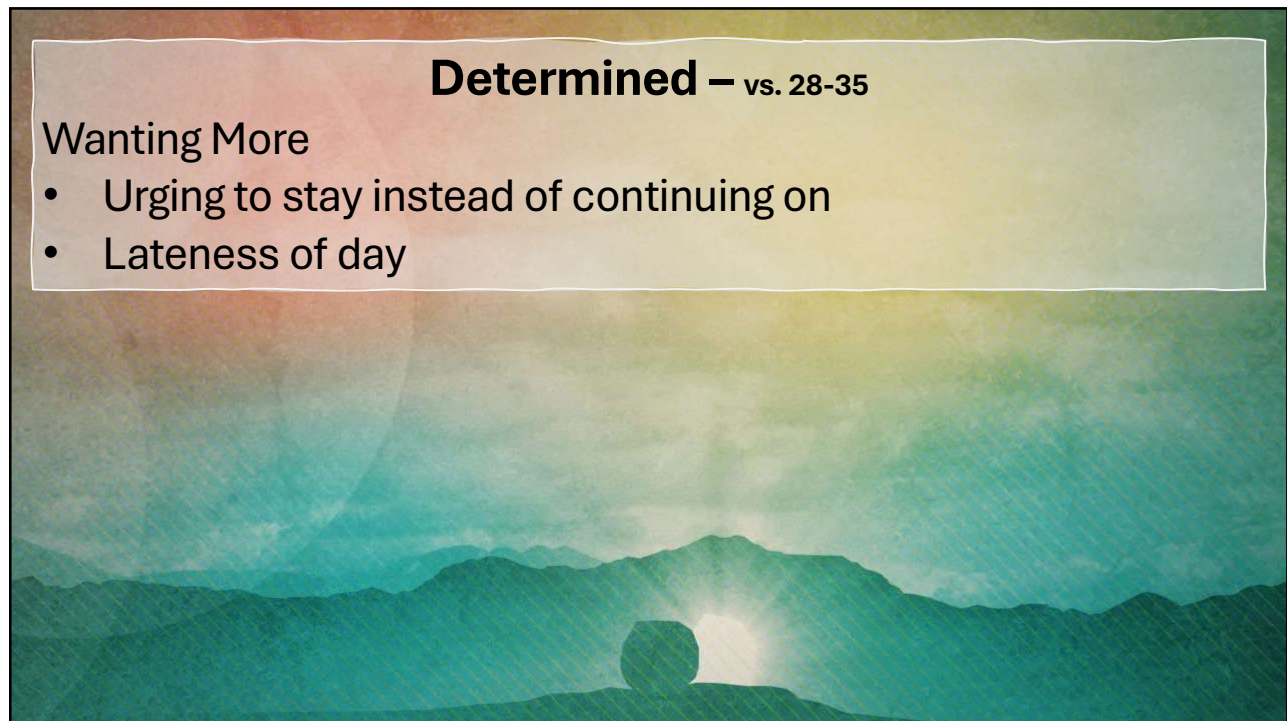




Determined – vs. 28-35




Determined – vs. 28-35




Determined – vs. 28-35
