- Micah address both the north and south
 - Israel and Judah
 - Both had fallen away for God's plan and ways
- Justice intended to be anchored in the Mosaic Law
- Law was given to provide guidelines for:
 - Worshiping God
 - Foreshadowing of atonement
 - Relationship with others
 - Other Israelites
 - All others



- Cry for relief not repentance









- Demonstrates God's mercy and grace





Ultimate Protection vs. 9-12

At What Cost

- Ungodly and unjust rulers build their earthly kingdoms
 - Detest justice; especially when justice is pronounced on the evil leader
 - Make the crooked all that is straight



Ultimate Protection vs. 9-12

At What Cost

- Ungodly and unjust rulers build their earthly kingdoms
- Build and gain more
 - Blood shed to gain
 - Leading people to sin to gain

Ultimate Protection vs. 9-12

At What Cost Sell Out

- Paying off judges to tip the scale of justice
- Paying off priest to teach peace instead of truth of sin
- Paying off prophets no to give the words of warning from God

- "Lean on the Lord" outwardly
- "Is not the LORD in the midst of us" false assertions about God
- "No disaster shall come upon us." denying the reality of judgement and sin

2 Timothy 4:1–5

I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths. But as for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.
