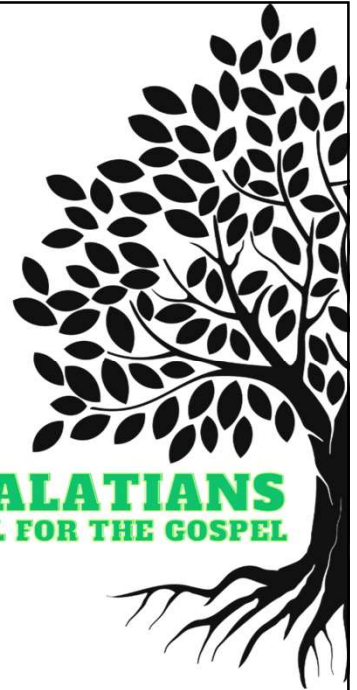

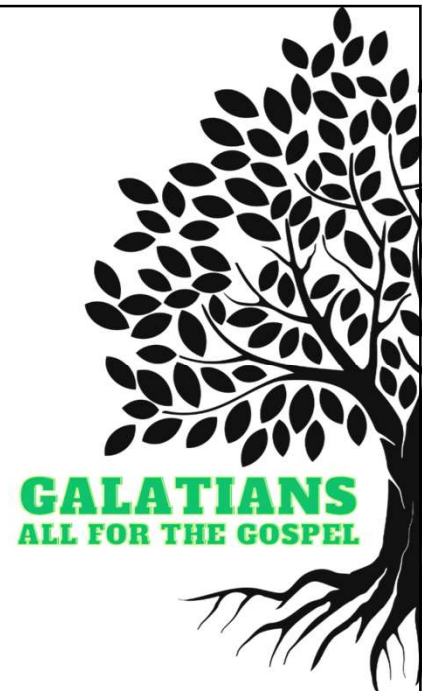

  - Grace alone salvation



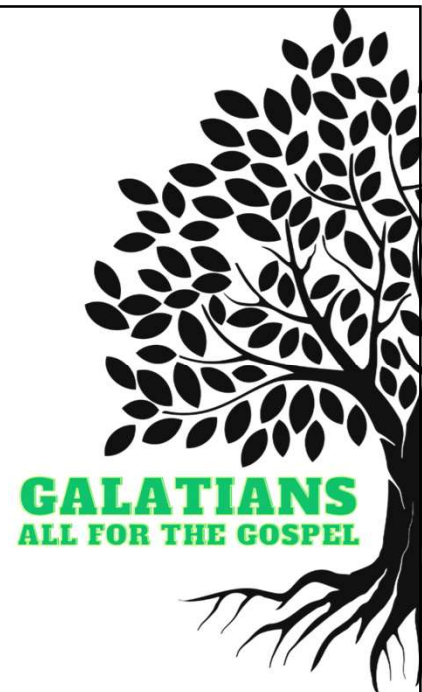

  - Worked against Paul many times

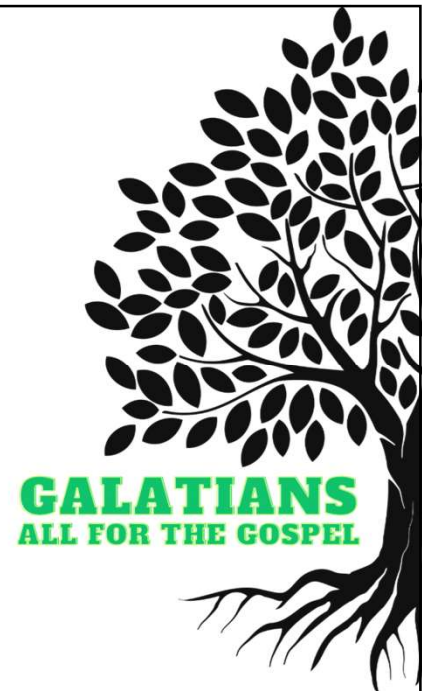
## Added Gospel

Legalism Insisted

- Taking away the freedom in Christ
- Slavery to the law (the law – how to love God and others)
- Legalism – “Right behavior with wrong belief”
- “Grace alone is not enough”

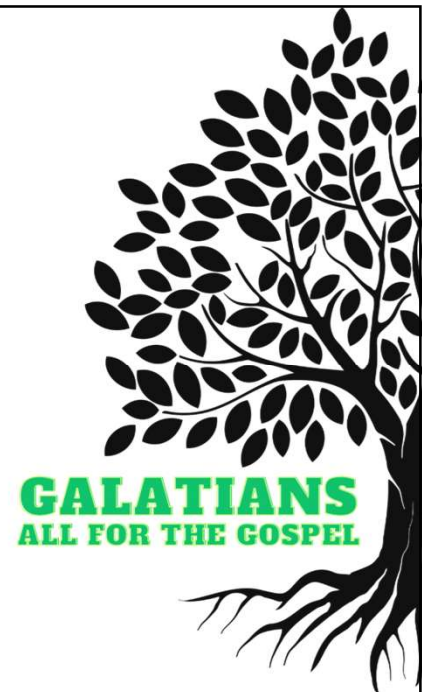
Determined Anchor

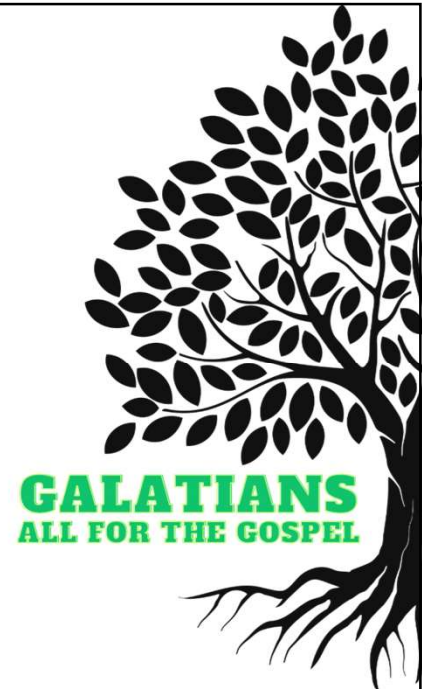

  - Fear of others

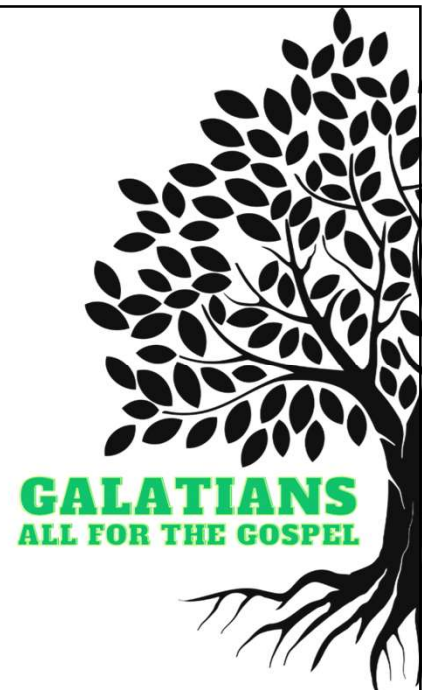

## Wavering Gospel

- Hypocrisy spreads
- Hypocrisy hurts the fellowship

## **Solid Gospel**

Galatians 2:15–17

[15] We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; [16] yet we know that a person is not **justified** by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be **justified** by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be **justified**.

[17] But if, in our endeavor to be **justified** in Christ, we too were found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not!

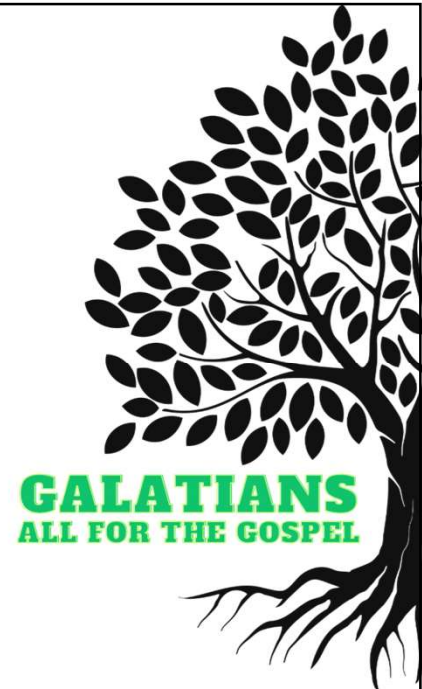

## Solid Gospel

### Justification

- The gracious act of God by which God declares a sinner righteous
  - Gracious act – unearned, not capable of being earned favor – that is purposeful
  - From God and only God
  - Declares – authority to declare
  - Sinner – everyone’s birth status, demonstrated through disobedience to God
  - Righteous – holy, purified, right with God



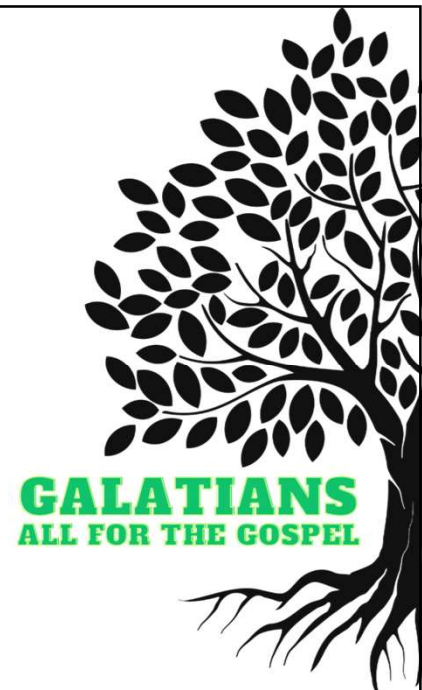

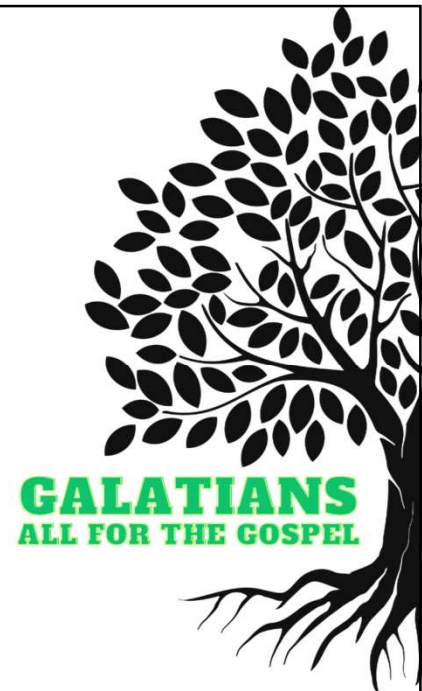
## Solid Gospel

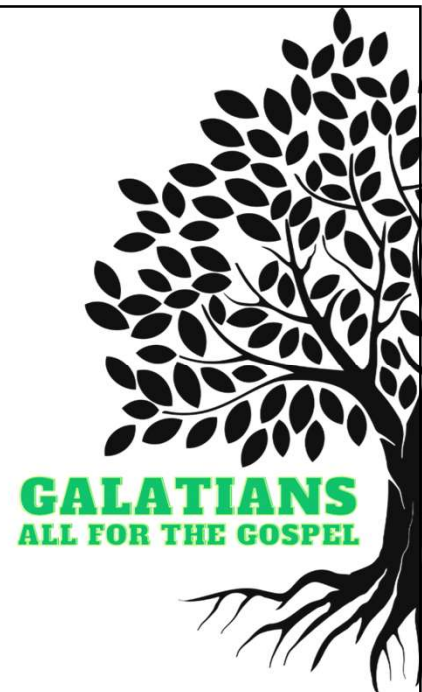

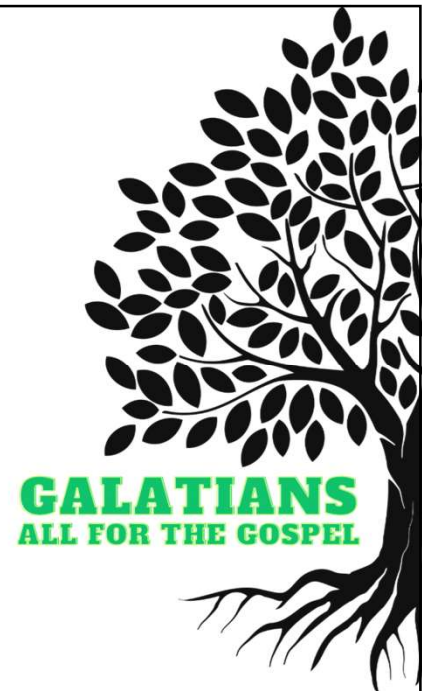

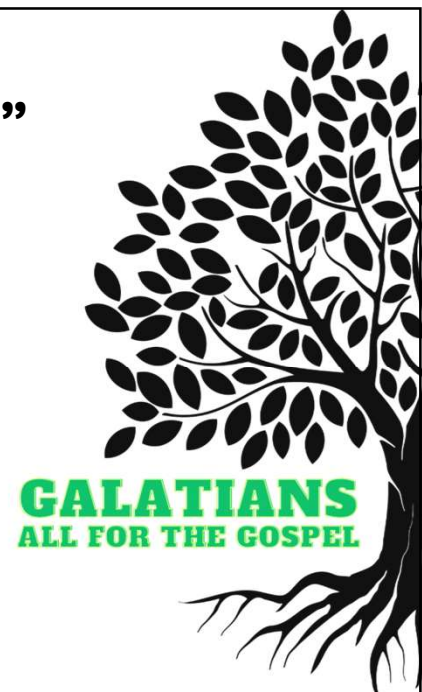
If Righteousness Gained Through The Law....
