

Determined Anchor


- Paul's desire for confirmation of unity

 - Grace alone salvation





Will Titus be welcomed


- Apostles welcome Paul, Barnabas, and Titus

- "Grace alone is not enough"



You Can Do Nothing To Gain More Favor... Right Behavior With Wrong Belief Does Not Add More Grace.



The Gospel Is Stands Regardless Of Surroundings


- Pater remember the history

 - Fear of others






- Hypocrisy hinders the testimony







Solid Gospel

Galatians 2:15–17

[15] We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; [16] yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.


[17] But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we too were found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not!



Solid Gospel

Justification

- The gracious act of God by which God declares a sinner righteous
 - Gracious act unearned, not capable of being earned favor that is purposeful
 - From God and only God
 - Declares authority to declare
 - Sinner everyone's birth status, demonstrated through disobedience to God
 - Righteous holy, purified, right with God





 - "A different gospel"


