

#### **NUMBERS 13:25-33**

At the end of forty days they returned from spying out the land. And they came to Moses and Aaron and to all the congregation of the people of Israel in the wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh. They brought back word to them and to all the congregation, and showed them the fruit of the land. And they told him, "We came to the land to which you sent us. It flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. However, the people who dwell in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large. And besides, we saw the descendants of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the Negeb. The Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the hill country. And the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and along the Jordan."


But Caleb quieted the people before Moses and said, "Let us go up at once and occupy it, for we are well able to overcome it." And there we saw the Nephilim (the sons of Anak, who come from the Nephilim), and we seemed to ourselves like grasshoppers, and so we seemed to them."

#### THE JOURNEY OF THE SPIES







- Faith requires boldness
- x Expected backlash
- Character rewarded Fast-forward Caleb's reward
  - ¤ Joshua 14:6-15
    - x At age 40 stood in faith
    - Wondered with the Children of Israel 40 years in the wilderness
    - x 45 years later, given the land he spied out
    - God's favor even through the wilderness

- ¤ Disobedience punished Numbers 14
  - Negative popular report wins over the heart of the people
  - ¤ Rebellion Num. 14:1-3; 10
  - ¤ Plea for obedience Num. 14:4-9
  - x Anger of God Num. 14:10-13
  - ¤ Judgment − Num. 14:20-25
