"GETTING RID OF ENVY"

Genesis 37:3-4 – Jacob loved Joseph more than any of his other children because Joseph had been born to him in his old age. So one day Jacob had a special gift made for Joseph—a beautiful robe. But his brothers hated Joseph because their father loved him more than the rest of them. They couldn't say a kind word to him.

Envy: <u>Discontentment</u> with what I have and <u>resentment</u> with what you have.

Genesis 37:18-20 – When Joseph's brothers saw him coming, they recognized him in the distance. As he approached, they made plans to kill him. "Here comes the dreamer!" they said. "Come on, let's kill him and throw him into one of these cisterns. We can tell our father, 'A wild animal has eaten him.' Then we'll see what becomes of his dreams!"

The truth about envy:

- 1. It ruins our relationships.
 - 1 Corinthians 13:4 (ESV) Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant.
- 2. It robs us of enjoyment.
 - **James 3:16** (NIV) For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.
- 3. It rots our bodies.
 - **Proverbs 14:30** (NIV) A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.
 - **Job 5:2** (NIV) Resentment kills a fool, and envy slays the simple.

"GETTING RID OF ENVY"

Getting rid of envy:

1. Avoid the temptation to compare.

• Isaiah 45:9 – "What sorrow awaits those who argue with their Creator. Does a clay pot argue with its maker? Does the clay dispute with the one who shapes it, saying, 'Stop, you're doing it wrong!' Does the pot exclaim, 'How clumsy can you be?""

2. Celebrate God's goodness to others.

Philippians 4:4-5 – Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon.

3. Celebrate God's goodness to you.

• James 1:17 (ESV) – Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.
