# Because Jesus <u>sat down,</u> you can look up.

Colossians 3:1-4 (ESV) – If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

#### 1. Look up to greater purpose.

- Christ was raised and seated.

  - Set your <u>mind</u> and your <u>mouth</u> on truth, love, grace, unity, and forgiveness.

  - Set your mind on <u>thanksgiving</u>; seek to <u>serve</u>
     Jesus in everything.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5-7 (ESV) We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ, being ready to punish every disobedience, when your obedience is complete. Look at what is before your eyes. If anyone is confident that he is Christ's, let him remind himself that just as he is Christ's, so also are we.

#### 2. Look at greater peace.

- Colossians 3:17 (ESV) And whatever you do, in word or deed, do
  everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the
  Father through him.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV) For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
