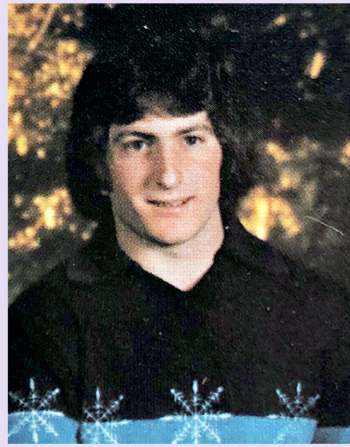

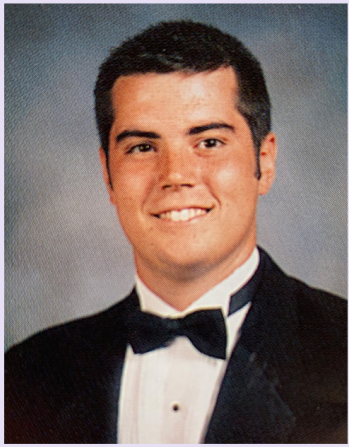

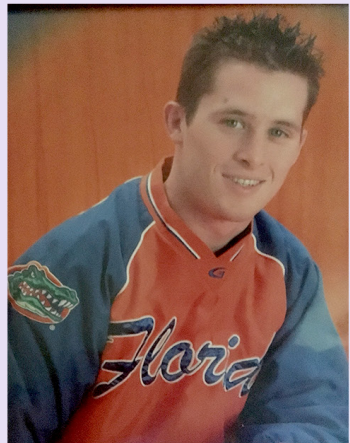

Judges 14:1-3, 8-11, 19 - One day when Samson was in Timnah, one of the Philistine women caught his eye. ²When he returned home, he told his father and mother, "A young Philistine woman in Timnah caught my eye. I want to marry her. Get her for me." ⁸Later, when he returned to Timnah for the wedding, he turned off the path to look at the carcass of the lion. And he found that a swarm of bees had made some honey in the carcass. ⁹He scooped some of the honey into his hands and ate it along the way. He also gave some to his father and mother, and they ate it. But he didn't tell them he had taken the honey from the carcass of the lion. ¹⁰As his father was making final arrangements for the marriage, Samson threw a party at Timnah, as was the custom for elite young men. ¹¹When the bride's parents saw him, they selected thirty young men from the town to be his companions. But Samson was furious about what had happened, and he went back home to live with his father and mother.

Judges 15:3,7-8, 11 - Samson said, "This time I cannot be blamed for everything I am going to do..." ⁷"Because you did this," Samson vowed, "I won't rest until I take my revenge on you!" ⁸So he attacked the Philistines with great fury and killed many of them. They said to Samson, "What are you doing to us?" But Samson replied, "I only did to them what they did to me."
