

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: GOD SENDS PHILIP TO AN ETHIOPIAN

LESSON SUMMARY:

Ask your child what they learned about this week:

An angel tells Philip to head south. As he does, he sees an Ethiopian in a carriage. The Holy Spirit tells him to walk beside the carriage, and Philip tells the Ethiopian about Jesus. Later, the Holy Spirit snatches Philip away and puts him in a new spot. **The Holy Spirit gives us direction**.

HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Whenever you're out with your family, ask the Holy Spirit to show you people who need help. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you how you can help the people you see. It might be buying a meal at a fast food restaurant, giving them a kind word, or something else. Have family members share what direction the Holy Spirit is giving them, and then follow his leading together.

AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What's an area of your life in which you need more direction?

AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!" 2 Corinthians 5:17

PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

The Holy Spirit gives us direction. Kids are used to following directions from teachers and parents. But sometimes they have to make decisions on their own. Help them see that when they listen to the Holy Spirit, the Holy Spirit can give them direction. Pray that you and your child(ren) will recognize the Holy Spirit's prompting in your life.
