Remembrance Day (also known as Poppy Day) is a memorial day in Commonwealth States since the end of the First World War to honor armed forces members who died in the line of duty. Remembrance Day is observed November 11th to recall the end of First World War hostilities, which ended " the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month" of 1918. In the US, we dedicate November 11 to honor all veterans.
