Not Just For The First Century

Louis C.K. was on Conan O'Brien's late-night talk show, where he described today's entitlement culture. He said in our culture, "Everything's amazing and nobody's happy."

Louis was on a plane that offered in-flight Wi-Fi access to the Internet, one of the first planes to do so. But when it broke down, the man sitting next to him swore in disgust. Louis was amazed, and said to O'Brien, "How quickly the world owes him something that he didn't know existed 10 seconds ago."

Louis then talked about how many of us describe less-than-perfect airline flights as if they were experiences from a horror film: "It was the worst day of my life. First of all, we didn't board for 20 minutes! And then we get on the plane and they made us sit there on the runway for 40 minutes!"

Then he said mockingly, "Oh really? Did you fly through the air incredibly, like a bird? Did you partake in the miracle of human flight? ... Everybody on every plane should be going, 'O ... wow!' ... You're sitting in a chair in the sky!"

It's easy to complain even in the good times, but what does that get you?

Don't murmur and complain. Don't become critical and whine about your circumstances every time they don't match up to your expectations.

When you're grumbling, you fail to appreciate even the good gifts you have from God.

Don Kistler put it this way: "The person with the discontented heart has the attitude that everything he does for God is too much, and everything God does for him is too little."

Paul commanded: "Do everything without complaining or arguing" (Philippians 2:14). Those words were not just for the first century Christian.
