Modern Critical Scholarship On The Resurrection Of Jesus (Part 1)

It is common knowledge that most state and public colleges and universities have Religion departments that deny the literal, bodily resurrection of Jesus. Decades ago, it was common to hear scholars question whether Jesus was actually a real person. Did He ever really exist?

That said, you may be surprised to learn modern scholarship has come a long way in a very short period of time ... why? Because critical scholars agree the New Testament books and the people in them (Jesus, Peter, Paul, etc.) should be evaluated on the same grounds as any other historical text or figure. No additional prejudice. On those grounds, modern critical scholarship agrees with 4 undeniable facts:

Jesus was a real person, a historical figure

He was a Jewish Teacher / Rabbi

- He was crucified under the rule of Pontus Pilate
- He was believed to be resurrected from the dead within a very short period (even days) after His crucifixion.

The most noted critical New Testament Scholar in the US, possibly the world, Bart Erdman, has said these facts are undeniable and that no credentialed New Testament scholar would doubt these facts today.

They still don't like the Gospels or Peter and John's epistles, as they don't believe in the authorship, and think they were written late. They are not sure about the empty tombs, backroom deals with Roman soldiers, and most of the group resurrection accounts.

But they do like Paul. They accept his authorship of 7 of his epistles; they believe he is an honest man; they see him as a scholar of the highest order (probably why they like him ... they seem him as one of their own). They see Paul as:

A leading Pharisee schooled by Gamaliel.

His theological arguments are well framed and reasoned.

Most importantly, Paul is a first-person eyewitness. He tells you what he thinks, not what he heard others say, saw, or think.

Paul is called the Darling of the New Testament Critics. Robert Hall
