Several years ago, *The Onion*, a satirical magazine, ran a humorous article with a biting truth. They titled the article, "World Death Rate Holding Steady at 100 Percent." The article reported: "World Health Organization officials expressed disappointment Monday at the group's finding that, despite the enormous efforts of doctors, rescue workers and other medical professionals worldwide, the global death rate remains constant at 100 percent.

Death, a metabolic affliction causing total shutdown of all life functions, has long been considered humanity's number one health concern. Responsible for 100 percent of all recorded fatalities worldwide."

¹⁹ Everyone also to whom God has given wealth and possessions and power to enjoy them, and to accept his lot and rejoice in his toil—this is the gift of God. ²⁰ For he will not much remember the days of his life because God keeps him occupied with joy in his heart (Ecclesiastes 5:18–20).

Find hope in life! For living people have the opportunity for reward. They can feel, and they can share in life's events—the birth of a child, graduation ceremonies, weddings, birthday parties, family gatherings, and vacations. Even though death is inevitable, there is so much to live for!
