Never Beyond His Sight

Jesus was on a mountain and the disciples were alone in a boat on the Sea of Galilee. And after a few hours a storm came up. By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. (John 6:17-18)

Not only were they in a storm, but they were also in the middle of the lake. In other words, they were the farthest point from any shore.

About this time, the disciples may have been having a little bit of a flashback. If you know your gospels you know there was another storm the disciples had earlier found themselves in, described in Matthew 8.

Without warning, a furious storm came up. Yet Jesus was sleeping. The disciples woke him, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" He rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

The difference this time (John 6) was Jesus was not in the boat. He was on a mountain praying. All they knew was that he was not where they wanted him to be, on the boat with them in the storm. They are probably grumbling: "Where is Jesus when we need him? He is no where to be seen. Does he care?" But the gospel of Mark says that just because he is absent physically, he is not absent.

He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night, he went to them, walking on the lake (Mark 6.48).

It was storming. It was night. It was pitch black. But Jesus saw them. He was not seeing with his eyes but with his divine power. He had not neglected them. He was aware of their plight.

We are never beyond his sight! "Do not fear."
