Not Always The Way We Want

Have you ever felt God just wasn't listening? Silent, uncaring, even absent? Perhaps you have a problem, a need, a pain, a burning question; you bring it before God, and nothing happens. You remember Jesus said persist in prayer, so you go on battering at heaven for an answer that doesn't come. Habakkuk doesn't pull any punches:

"O YHWH, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not listen?" [Hab 1:1]

Here is the problem of unanswered prayer from a righteous man, a man of God who is asking on behalf of his people, not for himself. Habakkuk knows the thing to do with a problem is to take it to God. He has been doing just that. But he doesn't get any answer. His heart cries out in perplexed bewilderment.

Have you ever felt that way?

What makes the book of Habakkuk unique among the prophets is that Habakkuk never talks to the people of Judah. It is, instead, a dialogue between one man and his God. That is what makes it so immediate, so relevant. Like Habakkuk, each of us at some time wrestles with God's incomprehensible silence. As God answers Habakkuk:

"Look at the nations and see! Be astonished! Be astounded! For a work is being done in your days that you would not believe if you were told." [Hab 1:5]

In other words, God says, "I am answering your prayer, Habakkuk. You accuse me of silence, but you just don't know how to recognize my answer. It is so different from what you expect that you won't even believe it when I tell you. But I'll tell you anyway."

God's ways are way beyond our comprehension. God does answer prayer, though not always the way we want.
