### **Getting Along**

It will be forever known that Eudodia and Syntyche didn't get along. How's that for a legacy? We don't know if they solved their problem. We don't even know what the problem was. However, their disagreement seemed to shake the church and threaten its unity.

Paul doesn't take sides. He simply says they should agree with each other. More precisely, He said, "Therefore, my brothers, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, that is how you should stand firm in the Lord, dear friends! I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to agree with each other in the Lord" (Philippians 4:1-2).

Paul urged the ladies to put aside their disagreement and find agreement in the Lord. This means that whatever we differ about, we ought to agree on Jesus, the gospel, and His grace. Put aside temporary things and remember Jesus is Lord of this church.

The word "agree" is about harmony. If two pianists were playing at the same time but pounding out different songs, it's just noise. Paul wants these ladies to play the same song, and that song is Jesus.

A church fight scare us. An argument between two of our people, whatever it may be about, is everyone's business. Paul told his friend in Philippi to "help these women" (v. 3); get involved in making peace. It is our business because the church is not an institution, or a club, or a loose gathering of interested people. It is the body of Christ. We are family. Are we not trying to build the kingdom of God here?

If we allow personal disagreements to divide the body, we do immense damage to the gospel in the world. Disunity in the church is disastrous and contrary to God's plan for us as his people. So, stand firm in the Lord.
