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Taking A Stand

Daniel then said to the guard, “Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food.” (Daniel 1:11-13)

Jesus said, “It is the one who is least among you all who is the greatest” (Luke 9:48), and “The greatest among you will be your servant. Those who humble themselves will be exalted” (Matthew 23:11-12). Clearly, followers of Jesus take certain positions that the world will not understand.

Such was the case for four young Jews exiled to Babylon. Chosen to one day serve the king, Daniel and his three friends were given the best of Babylonian education, training, and food. Non-kosher food. Daniel boldly said, “No, thank you!” and offered to be part of an experiment. The guard agreed, and “at the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food” (Daniel 1:15).

Immersed in a pagan culture, these four young men stayed true to the one true God. Key was the fact that they had one another. Theirs was a small but clearly adequate community of fellowship and support in this strange, new world.
