Will He See Me?

Even more than they hated the Romans, the Jews hated their own people who worked for the Romans, as tax collectors. Zacchaeus was a tax collector.

You paid up, or they turned you over to the Romans as a tax-dodger. The Romans could confiscate your property, have you flogged, or sold as a slave. Tax collectors got rich, because they could take whatever they liked from whomever they liked. Zacchaeus was a tax collector.

The money a tax collector made was so dirty Jews always had the exact amount due, so he wouldn't have to touch the tax collector's money. The only friends tax collectors had were other outcasts. And Zacchaeus was a tax collector.

Have you ever felt you were in such a mess that there was no way back, no way to start over clean? Have you ever felt you were so bad God wouldn't be interested in you? Or have you ever felt you were so small God couldn't see you?

The Bible doesn't tell us why Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus. Maybe he'd heard Jesus was different. Maybe he'd heard he made lepers clean and, most astonishing of all, ate with prostitutes and other sinners. What did Zacchaeus want? We don't know. Maybe he felt dirty on the inside and wondered if Jesus could make tax collectors clean, too.

Jesus saw him. Above the bustle and noise and press of people, Jesus saw the one man everyone in town would have turned their back on. Jesus saw this man, whom everyone knew was so bad that God couldn't possibly want to have anything to do with him. Jesus saw Zacchaeus.
