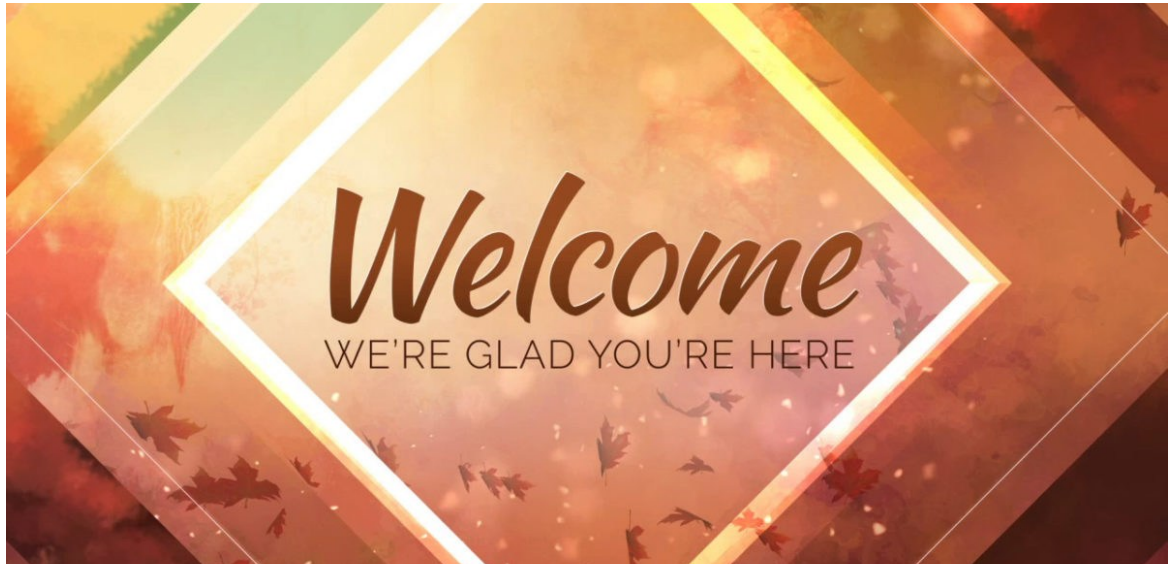

Do The Extraordinary

Throughout the years, Reader’s Digest has published a book series called, Extraordinary Uses for Ordinary Things. It offers various ways to “Save Money and Time”. Some of the suggestions can be pretty interesting. Here are a few examples:

Use a Balloon to Transport Cut Flowers – Don’t bother with awkward, water-filled plastic bags and such with traveling with freshly cut flowers. Simply fill up a balloon with about ½ a cup of water and slip it over the ends of your flowers. Wrap a rubber band several times around the mouth of the balloon to keep it from slipping off.

Use Butter to Remove Sap from Skin – You’ve just gotten home from a pleasant walk in the woods, but your hand is still covered with sticky tree sap that feels like it will never come off. Don’t worry. Just rub butter on your hand and the gunky black sap will wash right off with soap and water.

Use Denture Tablets to Re-ignite Your Diamond’s Sparkle – Has your diamond ring lost its sparkle? Drop a denture tablet into a glass containing a cup of water. Follow that with your ring or diamond earrings. Let it sit for a few minutes. Remove your jewelry and rinse to reveal the old sparkle and shine.

Now, I would have never thought to use any of these items for any of these purposes. (I also have not tried any of these, so try these at your own risk.) But with the help of this book, I can find ways of doing the extraordinary with some rather ordinary items.

The same holds true of our lives. On my own wisdom and knowledge, I am nothing more than just another ordinary person. But when I begin to rely on the wisdom and knowledge that God provides me in His Book, His power will lead me to do the extraordinary!
