There's One More Thing

You ever wonder about this world? You ever wonder about what is right? Or about what is or isn't good?

An obscure Judean prophet hit on what God considers to be good. We read his words in the book bearing his name: The Lord God told us what is right and what he demands: "See that justice is done, let mercy be your first concern, and humbly obey your God" (Micah 6:8).

Let's start with who told us? The Lord God told us what is right, not our preacher, not Harry Wilson, not the pope, but God. He is the final authority.

See that justice is done. Micah uses a Hebrew word, which isn't surprising, seeing that Micah was a Hebrew. If he had of used a Swedish word that would have been surprising. The word he uses literally means, "divine law."

Earthly laws may change with the whim of the lawmakers. What is law this year may not be next year. But regardless of how many times earthly laws change, God's law always stays the same. Get it?

What does God require of us? The Lord God told us what is right and what he demands: "See that justice is done, let mercy be your first concern, and humbly obey your God."

What is mercy? The word Micah used literally meant kindness. So, God requires we make kindness our first concern. Do we love mercy, do we love kindness or are we just paying it lip service?

There's one more thing. Living justly is great, and loving mercy is fine, but it's not enough. The Lord God told us what is right and what he demands: "See that justice is done, let mercy be your first concern, and humbly obey your God."
