Jesus Was Serious

In May 2003, Aron Ralston used a pocketknife to amputate his right arm. He had been trapped by a boulder in a canyon near Moab, Utah, for five days. Running out of water realized it was his only chance to survive. After cutting off his arm he rappelled to the bottom of the canyon and hiked out to meet his rescuers.

Animals caught in traps will gnaw off a trapped limb to get free. But people – well, that's a whole different story. People tend to stay stuck in situations that will kill them. That's why Ralston's story made the news.

Jesus said: "If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to go into hell. [Mt 5:29-30] I prefer to skip those lines or interpret them as being hyperbole, the kind of dramatic exaggeration to get our attention.

I think what keeps us from taking Jesus' seriously is that we really don't fully grasp that sin is just as much a threat to our lives as those boulders that trapped Ralston. "It's not that big a deal," we say to ourselves, when we indulge in our favorite bad habit: a critical spirit, sense of entitlement, self-righteousness, thinking the worst of others, envy, impatience, failure to forgive. However Jesus was serious. We need to be as serious in removing sin as Ralston was in removing his arm. Our eternal life may depend on it.
