HOUSE OF MIRACLES – PART IV

THE POWER OF A RADICAL RESPONSE

The times in which we live are increasingly becoming more and more radical. The challenge is nothing less than ensuring that we protect our homes and save the next generation. We cannot match the radical agendas of the culture with spiritual complacency, indifference, and fatalism. What happens next has everything to do with your radical response. To see what you have never seen, you must do what you have never done.

RADICAL FAITH:

Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, ³ as His divine power <u>has given to us all things</u> that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, ⁴ by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust. (<u>2 PETER</u> 1:2-4, NKJV).

RADICAL OBEDIENCE

". . . Do whatever he tells you." (JOHN 2:5, NLT).

RADICAL PROVISION:

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (PHILIPPIANS 4:19, NKJV).

RADICAL FAITH + RADICAL OBEDIENCE = RADICAL PROVISION

A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets cried out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the Lord. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves." ² So Elisha said to her, "What

shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil." (2 KINGS 4:1-2, NKJV)

Then he said, "Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors—empty vessels; do not gather just a few. ⁴ And when you have come in, you shall shut the door behind you and your sons; then pour it into all those vessels, and set aside the full ones." ⁵ So she went from him and shut the door behind her and her sons, who brought *the vessels* to her; and she poured *it* out. ⁶ Now it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said to her son, "Bring me another vessel." (2 KINGS 4:3-6, NKJV)

And he said to her, "There is not another vessel." So the oil ceased. ⁷ Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debt; and you and your sons live on the rest." (2 KINGS 4:6-7, NKJV)
