



SERIES OVERVIEW:

 Jesus invites us to pray, and He even shares a prayer request of His own: pray for laborers. In His compassion, He invites those laborers to come unto Him and rest, and ultimately, He prays for all of us -even with our personality differences- to be one!

TRUTH ABOUT GOD:

- Yahweh invites us to pray and work for **unity**.
- <u>Unity</u>- the quality or state of not being multiple: **ONENESS**

TRUTH FOR MY LIFE:

• I will pray for and work toward <u>unity</u>.

THE TEXT: JOHN 17:1-26

JESUS PRAYS FOR HIMSELF

Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to Heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. <u>Glorify</u> Your Son, that Your Son also may <u>glorify</u> You, ² as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give Eternal Life to as many as You have given Him. ³ <u>And this is Eternal Life, that they may know You, the Only True God, and Jesus</u> <u>Christ whom You have sent. ⁴ I have glorified You on the Earth. I have finished the work</u> <u>which You have given Me to do</u>. ⁵ And now, O Father, <u>glorify</u> Me together with Yourself, with the <u>glory</u> which I had with You before the World was.

- Glorify-*doxazo* to praise, to extol, to magnify, to celebrate or to make renowned.
- Know-*ginosko* to learn to understand, to perceive, sexual intercourse between a man and a woman.
- Sent-*apostello* to order one to go to a place appointed or to set apart.
- Finished-*teleioo* to make perfect, to complete, or to accomplish.
- What is the toughest challenge of faith you have faced? How did you face it?

JESUS PRAYS FOR HIS DISCIPLES

⁶ "I have manifested Your Name to the men whom You have given Me out of the World.

They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your Word. ⁷ Now they have

known that all things which You have given Me are from You. ⁸ For I have given to them the Words which You have given Me; and they have received them and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.

- Manifested-<u>phaneroo</u>- to make visible, to make known, or to make actual and visible.
- Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.² In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴ And where I go you know, and the way you know."

⁵ Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" ⁶ Jesus said to him, "<u>I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.⁷ "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."</u>

⁸ Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." ⁹ Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? ¹⁰ Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.¹¹ Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves (JOHN 14:1-11).

 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, ⁷ but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross (PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8).

⁹ "<u>I pray for them. I do not pray for the World but for those whom You have given Me, for</u> <u>they are Yours</u>. ¹⁰ And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.¹¹ Now I am no longer in the World, but these are in the World, and I come to You. <u>Holy Father, keep through Your Name those whom You have given Me, that they may be</u> <u>one as We are</u>. ¹² While I was with them in the World, I kept them in Your Name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the Son of Perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. ¹³ But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the World, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves. ¹⁴ I have given them Your Word; and the World has hated them because they are not of the World, just as I am not of the World. ¹⁵ <u>I do not pray that You should take them out of the World, but that You should keep them from the Evil One</u>.

- One-*eis* single, solitary, or sole.
- <u>But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: "Every kingdom divided against</u> <u>itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not</u> <u>stand. ²⁶ If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his</u> <u>kingdom stand?</u> (<u>MATTHEW 12:22-26</u>).
- How do you feel knowing the Man Christ Jesus prayed for His Followers to be kept from the Evil One?

¹⁶ They are not of the World, just as I am not of the World. ¹⁷ <u>Sanctify them by Your Truth.</u>
<u>Your Word is Truth</u>. ¹⁸ As You sent Me into the World, I also have sent them into the World.¹⁹ And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be <u>sanctified</u> by the <u>Truth</u>.

- Sanctify-<u>hagiazo</u>- to separate from profane things dedicated to God, or to cleanse externally.
- Truth-*aletheia* in reality, in fact, or in certaintiy.
- What sure passages of Scripture do you run to when your World seems to spiral out of control?

JESUS PRAYS FOR UNITY OF ALL BELIEVERS

²⁰ "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their Word; ²¹ that they all may be <u>one</u>, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the World may believe that You sent Me. ²² And the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: ²³ I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the World may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

- And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." ²⁴ <u>Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.</u>
 ²⁵ And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed (<u>GENESIS 2:23-25</u>).
- Can two walk together, unless they are agreed? (AMOS 3:3)
- For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath. ¹⁷ But Jesus answered them, "<u>My Father has been working until now, and I have been working</u>." ¹⁸ Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God. ¹⁹ Then Jesus answered and said to them, "<u>Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.²⁰ For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel (JOHN <u>5:16-21</u>).</u>
- Why does our society often prefer division over <u>unity</u>? How can we foster more of a culture of <u>unity</u> in the church?

²⁴ "<u>Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me</u>; for You loved Me before the foundation of the World. ²⁵ O righteous Father! The World has not <u>known</u> You, but I have <u>known</u> You; and these have <u>known</u> that You <u>sent</u> Me. ²⁶ And I have <u>declared</u> to them Your Name, and will <u>declare</u> it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them."

- Declare-*gnorizo* to make known, to give understanding, or to gain through knowledge of.

- Therefore, if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, <u>if any affection and mercy</u>, ² fulfill my joy by being likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. ³ Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ⁴ Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others (PHILIPPIANS 2:1-4).
 - o Love-*agape* charity, affection, goodwill or benevolence.
 - o Accord-*sympsychos* of one mind, to be harmonious, or an agreement.
 - o Mind-*phroneo* the faculty that thinks, regards, feels, judges, or understands.
- What does it feel like to know our <u>unity</u> could be an answer to one of Jesus' own prayers?

- For Yahweh to keep us when the enemy sifts us.
- For Yahweh to <u>unify</u> us with our brothers and sisters.
