MARRIAGE

ONLY

"Don't use your body for sexual sin <u>like the people who do not know God</u>. The person who refuses to obey this is <u>disobeying God</u>, not simply a human teaching."

- · God's Standard for a Mate if You are a Christian
- a. The potential mate **must** be a **CHRISTIAN**
- b. The potential mate **must** have **LIFE**

PURPOSE compatibility.

c. The potential mate **should** have **PERSONALITY** compatibility.

The Reward for living God's Standard:
