- I. WHY TREAT EVERYONE WITH RESPECT?
- 1. BECAUSE GOD **CREATED** EVERYBODY.

"You (God) made them inferior only to yourself; you crowned them with glory and honor."

2. BECAUSE JESUS **DIED** FOR EVERYONE.

"God paid a ransom to save you ... He paid for you with the precious lifeblood of Christ."

1. WHEN YOU SPEAK TO PEOPLE ...

BE TACTFUL NOT JUST TRUTHFUL.

2. WHEN YOU ARE SERVED BY PEOPLE ...

BE **UNDERSTANDING** NOT **DEMANDING**.

"Do to others as you would have them do to you."

"A wise, mature person is known for his understanding. The <u>more pleasant</u> his words, the <u>more persuasive</u> he is."

3. WHEN YOU DISAGREE WITH PEOPLE ...

BE **GENTLE** NOT **JUDGMENTAL**.

"Each of us will give an account of ourselves to God. Therefore, let us <u>stop passing judgment</u> on one another.

Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister."

"Where there is jealousy and selfishness, there is also disorder ...

4. WHEN YOU SHARE YOUR FAITH WITH PEOPLE ...
