II. Purposes of Being Rooted in Prayer

Prayer expresses my D E V O T I O N and D E P E N D E N C E on God.

"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers... But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!"

JOHN 15:5-7 (NLT)

2 Prayer D E E P E N S and S T R E N G T H E N S my ROOTS in Christ.

"I no longer call you servants because a servant doesn't know his master's business. Instead I have called you friends... I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for in my name."

JOHN 15:15-16 (NLT)

"Come close to God and God will come close to you."

JAMES 4:8 (NLT)

Prayer deepens my ROOTS when God A N S W E R S

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. <u>Tell God what you need</u>, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus." "I tell you the truth, the Father will give you whatever you <u>ask</u> in My name...<u>Ask</u> and you will receive, and your joy will be complete."

* P R A Y E R is God's chosen method for meeting your needs.

"He fulfills the desires of those who reverence and trust him."
