I. GOD THE FATHER CARES.

"As a father has <u>compassion</u> on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him, for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust."

II. GOD THE FATHER IS CONSISTENT.

"Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from <u>the Father</u> ... who does not change like shifting shadows." JAMES 1:17 | NIV

• INCONSISTENT FATHERS PRODUCE **INSECURE** CHILDREN.

"If we are faithless, <u>He will remain faithful</u>, for He cannot disown Himself."

2 TIMOTHY 2:13 | NIV

"What a God he is! How perfect in every way! <u>All</u> his promises prove true!"

III. GOD THE FATHER IS **CLOSE** TO YOU.

"God did this so that (people) would ... reach out for him and find him, though <u>he is not far</u> from any one of us."
