# 1 Joseph's Challenges

## \* HATED and HURT at home

[His brothers] hated Joseph and couldn't speak to him on friendly terms.

GENESIS 37:4b (GW)

"Let's not kill him... let's throw him alive into this well here that way he'll die without our touching him!"

**GENESIS 37:22 (LB)** 

### \* SEDUCED and SLANDERED at work

After a while his master's wife began to desire Joseph and asked him to go to bed with her. He refused... although she asked Joseph day after day...

GENESIS 39:7-8,10b (GN)

"...That Hebrew slave you've had around here tried to rape me..."

**GENESIS 39:17 (LB)** 

## \* <mark>A L O N E and <mark>A B A N D O N E D </mark>in prison</mark>

"...Please be kind enough to mention me to the king and help me get out of this prison..." But the wine steward never gave Joseph another thought -- he <u>forgot all about him.</u>

GENESIS 40:14b, 23 (GN)

## 2 Joseph's Character

#### \* Fulfill my R E S P O N S I B I L I T I E S

...Potiphar gave Joseph <u>complete</u>... <u>responsibility</u> over everything he owned. He hadn't a worry in the world with Joseph there... **GENESIS 39:6 (LB)** 

...The jailer soon handed over the <u>entire prison</u> <u>administration</u> to Joseph... [and] had no more worries after that, for Joseph took care of everything...

**GENESIS 39:22-23 (LB)** 

...Pharaoh said, "Who could do a <u>better job</u> than Joseph? For he is a man who is obviously filled with the Spirit of God."

**GENESIS 41:38 (LB)** 

"The [person] who is f<u>aithful in the little things</u> will be faithful in the <u>big things</u>, and the [one] who cheats in the little things will cheat in the big things too."

LUKE 16:10 (PH)

Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

COLOSSIANS 3:23 (NLT)

#### \* Maintain my I N T E G R I T Y

Although she kept asking Joseph day after day, he refused to go to bed with her or be with her.

**GENESIS 39:10 (GW)** 

"...<u>My master trusts me</u> with everything in this entire household... How can I do such a wicked thing as this? It would be a great sin against God!"

**GENESIS 39:8-9 (LB)** 

Wicked people bring about <u>their own downfall</u> by their evil deeds, but good people are <u>protected</u> by their integrity.

PROVERBS 14:32 (GN)

#### \* Trust God's SOVEREIGNTY

"<u>God</u> sent me ahead of you... to save your lives in an amazing way. <u>It wasn't you who sent me here</u>, but God."

**GENESIS 45:7-8a (GW)** 

"You intended to harm me, but <u>God intended it for good</u> to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives."

GENESIS 50:20 (NIV)

Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

PROVERBS 3:5-6 (NLT)

But <u>WHATEVER HAPPENS</u>, make sure that your everyday life is worthy of the Gospel of Christ.

PHILIPPIANS 1:27 (PH)
