From Liar to Leader

Genesis 31-32

1 The process often begins with Relational C O N F L I C T

Jacob heard that Laban's sons were saying, "Jacob has taken everything our father owned and has gained all this wealth from what belonged to our father." And Jacob noticed that Laban's attitude toward him was not what it had been.

GENESIS 31:1-2 (NIV)

...the messengers returned to Jacob and reported, "We met your brother, Esau, and he is already on his way to meet you—with an army of 400 men!" Jacob was <u>terrified</u> at the news.

GENESIS 32:6-7a (NLT)

Then Jacob prayed, "O God... O Lord... I am not worthy of all the unfailing love and faithfulness you have shown to me... please, rescue me... I am afraid..."

GENESIS 32:9-11 (NLT)

God blesses those who... realize their need for him.

MATTHEW 5:3 (NLT)

2 Next comes a C R I S I S

After taking [his family] to the other side he sent over all of his possessions. This left Jacob all alone in the camp, and a man came and wrestled with him until dawn began to break. When the man saw that he would not win the match, he touched Jacob's hip and wrenched it out of its socket.

GENESIS 32:23-25 (NLT)

Even in the womb, Jacob struggled with his brother; when he became a man, he even fought with God.

HOSEA 12:3 (NLT)

3 Then, my COMMITMENT is tested

Then the man said, "Let me go, for the dawn is breaking!" But Jacob said, "I will not let you go unless you bless me."

GENESIS 32:26 (NLT)

So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

GALATIANS 6:9 (NLT)

4 I cannot grow to the next level unless I C O N F E S S

The man asked him, "What is your name?" "Jacob," he answered.

GENESIS 32:27 (NIV)

5 Ultimately, If I cooperate with God, I am C H A N G E D

"Your name will no longer be Jacob," the man told him.
"From now on you will be called Israel..." Then he blessed
Jacob there.

GENESIS 32:28-29 (NLT)

And you will be given a <u>new name</u> by the LORD's own mouth.

ISAIAH 62:2b (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17 (NLT)

The sun rose above him as he passed Peniel, and he was <u>limping</u> because of his hip.

GENESIS 32:31 (NIV)
