# I. WHY SHOULD I FORGIVE?

# 1. BECAUSE GOD HAS FORGIVEN ME.

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, <u>just as in Christ God forgave you</u>."

EPH. 4:32 | NIV

# 2. BECAUSE RESENTMENT CAUSES MORE PAIN

"To worry yourself to death with <u>resentment</u> would be a <u>foolish</u>, <u>senseless</u> thing to do."

JOB 5:2 | GN

"You are only hurting yourself with your anger!" JOB 18:4 | GN

"Some men stay <u>healthy</u> until the day they die... others have <u>no happiness at all</u>; they live and die with <u>bitter hearts</u>."

# 3. BECAUSE I WILL NEED

"For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."

#### FORGIVENESS IS NOT...

- ... MINIMIZING THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE OFFENSE
- ... INSTANT RESTORATION OF TRUST
- ... RESUMING THE RELATIONSHIP WITHOUT ANY CHANGES

# THE REQUIRED CHANGES ARE:

- 1. GENUINE REPENTANCE
- 2. **RESTITUTION** WHERE POSSIBLE
- 3. REBUILDING OF TRUST OVER A PERIOD OF TIME

## WE MUST LEARN TO SABBATH.
