When You Need a Miracle

• The principle is this: You must <u>ASK</u> <u>GOD</u> to work in your life.

Three Reasons We Don't Name Our Need

a. **PROCRASTINATION**

MARK 6:35 | NIV

b. **EXCUSES**

c. **INCONVENIENCE**

• Evaluate: Do I believe God can meet the need? Will I be involved in the miracle?

2 SEE <u>What</u> <u>I</u> <u>Already</u> <u>Have</u>

MARK 6:38 | NIV

• The principle is this: God <u>ALWAYS</u> <u>STARTS</u> with what we've got.

• Evaluate: How am I using what I already have?

JOHN 6:6 | NIV

God tests us to see if we will do what He says.

3 I GIVE GOD <u>WHAT I CAN</u>.

"Jesus took the five loaves and two fish, looked up toward heaven, and blessed them. Then, breaking the loaves into pieces, he kept giving the bread to the disciples so they could distribute it to the people. He also divided the fish for everyone to share. They all ate as much as they wanted, and afterward, the disciples picked up twelve baskets of leftover bread and fish. A total of 5,000 men and their families were fed."

MARK 6:41-44 | NLT

The principle is this: God will use <u>WHATEVER</u> I give Him.

• Core Value: You Can't OUT GIVE Good!

A Christian's Giving Journey

Step 1: Give SOMETHING

Step 2: Give REGULARLY

Step 3: Give the _______.

"Honor the Lord by giving him the <u>first part of all your income</u>." PROVERBS 3:9 | LB "Bring the whole <u>tithe</u> into the storehouse ... Test me in this,' says the Lord Almighty, 'and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it." MALACHI 3:10 | NIV

Step 4: Give SACRIFICIALLY .

• Willingness beats <u>OBLIGATION</u> .

"But remember this—if you give little, you will get little.
A farmer who plants just a few seeds will get only a small crop, but if he plants much, he will reap much.
Everyone must make up his own mind as to how much he should give. Don't force anyone to give more than he really wants to, for cheerful givers are the ones God prizes. God is able to make it up to you by giving you everything you need and more so that there will not only be enough for your own needs but plenty left over to give joyfully to others."
