- The epistle of I John is all about assurance.
- John wrote I John to everyone because we all have the question...How do you know that your experience with God is genuine?

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. I John 1:1

We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. I John 1:3

The miracles Jesus did pointed to a much higher reality - life in God.

The Spirit of God gives you an innate sense of God in which the truth about Jesus just makes sense to you. (I John 2:20-27)

One of the signs that you really know God, is you have fellowship (koinonia) with him through the Spirit.

And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him. I John 5:14-15
