## WHAT WE KNOW- AND DON'T KNOW-ABOUT HELL

Jesus says that the unrighteous "will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life." Matthew 25:46

But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes. He asked, "How did you get in here without wedding clothes, friend?" The man was speechless. Then the king told the attendants, "Tie him hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Matthew 22:11-13

- Hell means exclusion: Throw him outside...
- Hell is darkness: Throw him outside, into the darkness...
- Hell involves anguish: ...where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth

The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books ... [and] If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. Revelation 20:11-14

Hell is the absence of God!

## WHY HELL IS NECESSARY

Hell is necessary because human dignity demands it.

There is no one righteous, not even one... Romans 3:10
